Bard-in-a-Box: Tuesday, July 15, 12:30 – 1:30 pm

Kathy Doerr of St. Louis Shakespeare Company will present a program called "Bard-In-A-Box". She will come to campus carrying a large box of props, costumes, and scripts. The children will be put through the same physical/vocal warm-ups that professional actors do. She will then help the children perform their own version of a silly Shakespeare scene, such as "Pyramus & Thisbe" from "A Midsummer Night's Dream". Art Time, Wednesday, July 16, 10:15 -11:30 am

Giotto di Bondone was born near Florence in the mid-1200's. He was a shepherd who became a celebrated artist. The works of Giotto are important in the history of art because he was the first European artist to bring proper perspective to painting as well as using background images to give depth and movement. He was also the first to put expression and emotion in the faces of his subjects. We will learn a bit of history of both Giotto and early Renaissance art. The children will explore how to show emotions in people by painting facial expressions and body poses as well as adding depth and interest in a painting with proper perspective and the background. All art supplies will be provided; if parents could provide old clothing to cover the children's clothes, it would be appreciated.

Concordia Historical Institute Tour, Wednesday, July 16, 12:30-1:30 pm

Marie Roth will lead the children through a tour of the Museum at the Concordia Historical Institute. A brief explanation of various artifacts from the history of our Synod and the Lutheran Church will be seen. A sample of some of the items on display are Albrecht Durer's wood engravings, history of the mission work in Papua New Guinea, Katherine Luther, documents from the founding of the Synod, CFW Walther's piano, etc. For more information on CHI visit their website: <http://lutheranhistory.org>. Worship Space, Thursday July 17, 12:30-1:30 pm

The children will spend time in the Chapel of St. Timothy and St. Titus with Pastor Burreson, Dean of Chapel at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, exploring the worship space. They will learn the function of the various items and spaces in the chancel, nave and sacristy, getting an up close and personal look.

Story Time, Tuesday July 15, 10:15–11:30; Wednesday July 15, 12:30 – 1:30 for preschoolers and 1st graders.

In this session, the children will listen to some of Aesop's fables. We will discuss the fables and do associated activities such as coloring, acting out the story, games, etc.

Poetry Time, Thursday July 17, 10:15-11:30 am

The children will have an opportunity to enjoy listening to and reciting some children's poems, accompanied by discussion and activities.

Outdoor Play Time, daily, 1:45-2:45 pm

The children will be accompanied to and supervised at the playground, weather permitting. Please bring water bottles, sunscreen, and hats for your children. Frisbees, balls, skipping ropes, etc. are also welcome!

Indoor Play Time, Tuesday July 15, 3:15-4:15

The children will have supervised free play time. We will provide some card and board games, Legos, and other toys. Children are also welcome to bring a favorite toy or game to share.

Movie, Tuesday July 15, 6:30p

The children can come in their jammies and bring a blanket, pillow and favorite stuffed animal! We'll be serving popcorn and showing "The Sound of Music."

Toddlers at CCLE:

There will be a supply of activity bags for toddlers containing activities to quietly occupy your toddler during sessions. Each bag will contain a simple and independent activity such as Color Wonder markers and pages, a simple puzzle, stickers and paper, matching activities, large beads and string, etc. Parents may borrow one or two bags at a time and swap them between sessions.
