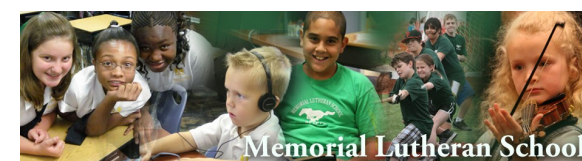

Memorial Lutheran School is located at 5800 Westheimer St at Bering Drive (one block west of Chimney Rock) just a mile west of the Galleria.

Directions:

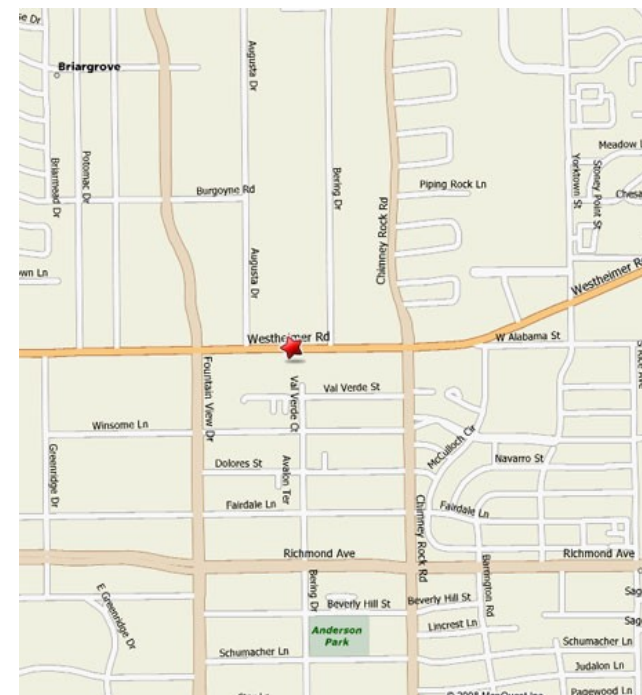
From the West Sam Houston Tollway exit at Westheimer, travel eastbound 4.62 miles and make a left at Bering Drive.

We are on the corner.

From the West Loop 610 exit at Westheimer, travel westbound 1.29 miles to Bering Drive, and make a right there.

We are on the corner.

From Sugar Land and Missouri City exit the Southwest Freeway US-59 at Chimney Rock. Turn left onto Chimney Rock and travel north to Westheimer. Turn left (westbound) onto Westheimer. Turn right at Bering Drive. We are on the corner.

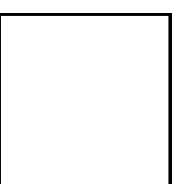
