

# **CCE 2019 Penmanship Contest**

## **open to CCE students in grammar level**

### **deadline submission: May 10, 2019**

The CCE penmanship competition is open to students of CCE-accredited schools and classical Lutheran homeschools.

Students will write out John 3:16 on lined paper using #2 pencil or black ink pen:

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16 KJV

#### **EVALUATION CRITERIA: SEE SCALES**

- legibility
- neatness
- shape/slant/connections
- spacing
- size
- spelling

#### **CONSIDERATIONS:**

1. Students will not trace or follow projections in any way. The submission will be entirely the student's handwriting on one side of paper only.
2. 6 and 7 year old students may only enter one penmanship contest (either manuscript or cursive).

#### **PROCESS:**

1. The classroom/homeschool teacher will explain the contest directions to the students. The student's first and last name and age should be in the upper right corner of the penmanship entry. The classroom/homeschool teacher completes the penmanship submission page by type of penmanship, student name, and age.
2. The classroom/homeschool teacher scans each penmanship submission as a pdf and emails the entries and submission form to Executive.director@cce.org. The entry must be clearly legible in the pdf to be evaluated. The Penmanship Judge 1 (PJ1) evaluates the entries and emails the entries to PJ2 and PJ3 for evaluation.

3. The penmanship submission page and the entries must be scanned and submitted electronically by midnight of the contest deadline, May 10, 2019.

When all PJs have completed the evaluations, they will have a telephone or electronic discussion to compare scores and identify winners. Winners will be announced at CCLE XIX.

4. Prizes consist of the following:

GRAND PRIZE – \$100 gift card for the scholar and \$50 gift card for the teacher

RUNNER-UP – \$50 gift card for the scholar and \$50 gift card for the teacher

5. All penmanship entries may be published in CCLE materials or activities with author attribution.
