

Consortium for Classical Exemplar Excellentiae Domi Award 2023

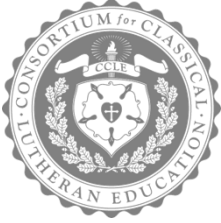
The Board of the Consortium for Classical Lutheran Education has established the Classical Exemplar Excellentiae Domi award for CCLE members who homeschool their children:

- ❖ To promote excellence in the practice and understanding of Classical Lutheran education
- ❖ To recognize and honor excellence in the performance of classical Lutheran homeschooling

1. If you wish to apply for the Classical Exemplar Excellentiae Domi Award, please complete the application.
2. The complete application consists of:
 - i. Application form
 - ii. letters of recommendation by your pastor and one other (non-related) adult
 - iii. narrative description of your homeschool
 - iv. identification of your best praxis in classical Lutheran home schooling
 - its fit in classical education (philosophy and methodology)
 - the curricular area
 - its role with Lutheran faith
 - the presentation of instruction
 - expectations of student performance (assignments, projects, etc.)
 - v. documentation of best praxis

All items should be submitted electronically (as a zip file, portfolio, etc.) to executive.director@cclle.org by December 31, 2022. There is NO application fee.

3. The CCLE board will evaluate your application and documentation. Decisions to award the Classical Exemplar Excellentiae Domi Award will be made after consideration by the entire CCLE Board and announced in the spring 2023.
4. Individuals selected for the award will receive a certificate, a modest financial award and waived conference registration for the next conference.
